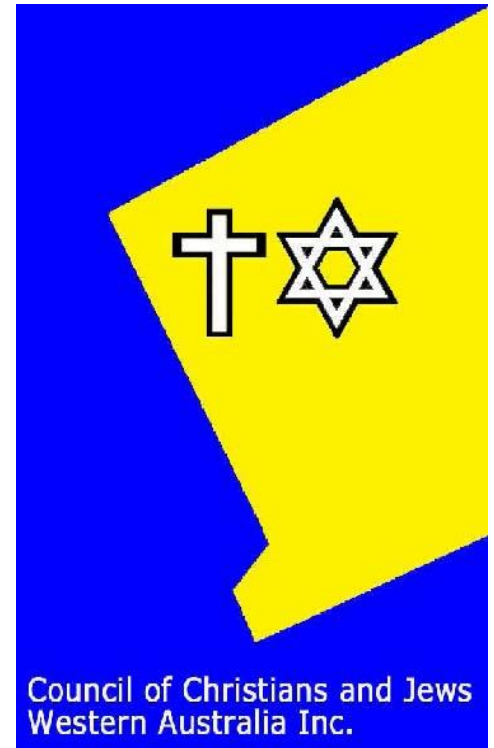
BACKGROUND

The original Council of Christians and Jews was established in Britain in 1942, as one means of addressing the ghastliness of Nazi anti-Semitism. The international centre for these networks is now in Germany and the first Australian Council was launched in Victoria in 1985. Launched in 1995, the Council of Christians and Jews, Western Australia, has joined this venture designed to promote understanding and cooperation between the religious traditions of Christians and Jews.

The Council of Christians and Jews, Western Australia, is endorsed by five religious communities and the religious leaders of those communities are joint Honorary Presidents of the organisation.

Membership of the Council of Christians and Jews is purely individual, but corporate support of the Council and its objectives is always welcome.

The Council's aims are entirely relevant to contemporary Australian Society in a world where anti-Semitism is again on the rise, and where religious tolerance is a fundamental value in our multicultural society.
