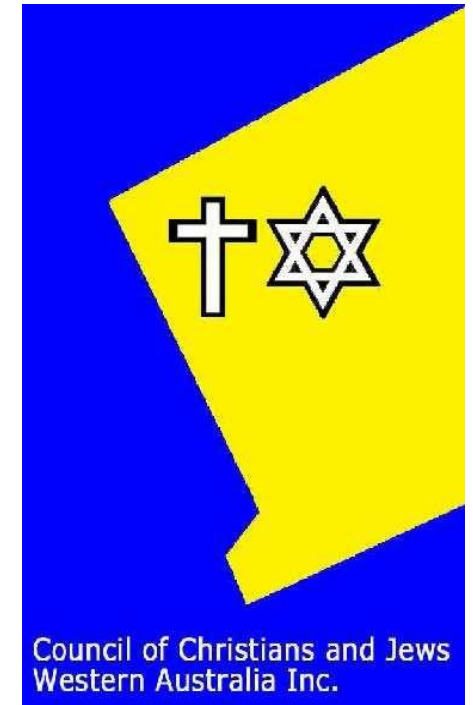
BACKGROUND

The original Council of Christians and Jews was established in Britain in 1942, as a means of addressing Nazi antisemitism. The first Australian Council was launched in Victoria in 1985. The Western Australian chapter of the Council of Christians and Jews was founded in 1995 to promote understanding and cooperation between the religious traditions of Christians and Jews.

The Council of Christians and Jews, Western Australia, is endorsed by five religious communities and the religious leaders of those communities are joint Honorary Presidents of the organisation.

Membership of the Council of Christians and Jews is individual, but corporate support of the Council and its objectives is always welcome.

The Council's aims are entirely relevant to contemporary Australian Society in a world where antisemitism is again on the rise, and where religious tolerance, diversity and inclusion are fundamental values in our multicultural society.
