Doctors Under A Dictatorship



There is a danger in the training of medical students that the spirit and ethics on which medicine is founded, may be ignored. Specialisation and advances in scientific medicine may create in the doctor an attitude of mind that his patient is merely an appendage to a diseased organ, or else, is only a complex biochemical machine with a conditioned nervous system. It is essential that the practising doctor and the medical student, commencing his clinical studies, realise that the patient is a human being of moral equality to every other human being in spite of race, religion, or upbringing. The doctor must recognise that life is sacred, and that it is his duty at all times to preserve it. The purpose of this paper is to illustrate how members of a medical profession, rich in medical tradition and once leaders in the world of medicine, became mass murderers when these basic principles were forgotten and ignored.


